

# Instrument Booking Rules

When booking time on any instrument please be considerate of other users by only booking the time that is needed to complete your experiments. In addition, please adhere to the following instrument specific booking rules:

## 400 MHz:

- Monday to Friday afternoons (1pm - 5pm) maximum time slot is 30 minutes
- For longer experiments always book in the morning or on weekends
- Overnight experiments cannot begin until 6pm and are to be finished by 8am (this includes removing your sample)

## 300 MHz:

- Same as the 400 MHz; however, undergraduate teaching labs will have unrestricted access during labs

## Cryoprobe 600 MHz (Science Complex):

- If necessary, we would like Wednesdays of each week are designated for short experiments and the maximum time slot will be 1 hour but would like some feedback prior to implementing this rule

## 600 MHz (MacN 305):

- Instrument will be available for solution work 1 week per month
- Upon booking time please contact a member of the NMR Centre staff regarding your experiments to ensure the proper probe is in place

If extenuating circumstances prevent you from following the posted booking rules please contact a member of the NMR Centre staff prior to booking.

Booked instruments sitting idle will not be tolerated:
